- Specialisterne employment for autistic people







Characteristics of social innovation

- Done by government, business and/or civil society
- Multidimensional & cross-disciplinary
- Need partnerships
- Often implemented through social enterprises
- Benefit from transnationality
- Digital tools can be useful
- Can be politically contentious
- Stimulate impact investing









ESFA support €197m 2021-27

- Grants: open calls to transfer/scale up SIs on:
 - effect of war in Ukraine €22m (deadline 30 May)
 - long-term uemployment €23m (deadline 30 September)
 - 2+ countries, 8% funding, lump sum
- Knowledge sharing: 4 communities of practice: SI / employment & skills / inclusión / results-based mgt
- Social Innovation Match database 150 organisations & projects (self-uploaded then verified)
- ALMA 29 youth internship projects
- EURoma
- 6 National Competence Centres + more on the way



Mainstream ESF+ funding

An R&D laboratory for new policies

Every MS must have:

>1 priority for SI

in >1 operational programme



Incentive: 95% funding



EaSI call for integrated interventions to support the most vulnerable (2020)

Common features of the 9 projects:

- Transnational public-NGO partnership
- Outreach difficulty recruiting participants
- Codesign working with clients and not for them
- Individual tailored coaching and case management
- Monitoring & evaluation → continuous learning



Going further

- Assemble evidence of effectiveness evaluation
- Impact on practice: scale up/replicate with possible ESF+ support
- Impact on policy through Joint Report of Social Protection Committee & Commission in 2025
